

UPDATE ON THE OLMC ROOF REPAIR PROJECT

Our roof repair project is in full swing despite weather delays. It includes repairing the subroof and replacing the waterproof membrane beneath the tiles. The work is detailed; as we are planning to save the tiles from the roof. The work is being paid for by OLMC from our savings account. On Feb 8th we will kick off a donation period for those that wish to make a donation to offset the roof repair cost which is estimated at \$85,000.0. More details coming!



