

READING II: ROMANS 8: 8-11

The Spirit dwells within us, so when God resurrects our mortal bodies, He completes the process of adoption that began with our Baptism.

**THE GOSPEL: JOHN 11:1-45, OR 11:3-7, 17,
20-27, 33B-45**

The raising of Lazarus is the sixth of the seven “signs” that Jesus performs in John’s gospel, which gives full support to Jesus’ claim to “give life.” For our purposes, note verse 35: “Jesus wept.”

A Message from Your Rector

Dear Members of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Montclair,

First of all I would like to say thank you very much to Dr. Zeni Fox for taking the time to come twice to our church in this Lenten season helping us to live more fully this liturgical time of penance in preparation for Easter.

I also would like to remind you to look at the schedule of the Easter Triduum that is in the bulletin because the three days of Holy Thursday (04/02), Good Friday (04/03) and Holy Saturday (04/04) have a schedule that is different from the regular schedule we have every week. In particular on Holy Thursday April 2nd we will have Morning Prayer at 8:30 am and the Mass of the Last Supper at 6 pm and after Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until 11 pm. The priest will be available for confessions from 7:15 pm to 10:45 pm. On Good Friday April 3rd also we will have Morning Prayer at 8:30 am, then Stations of the Cross at 2 pm, the Passion at 3 pm and after the priest will be available for confessions for one hour until approximately 5 pm. On Holy Saturday April 4th we will have Morning Prayer at 9:30 am, then confessions at 7 pm and Easter Vigil at 8 pm. This is the only Saturday in which we do not have a 4:30 pm mass.

I wish you a blessed Lenten season.


