Thank you for your past generosity to Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Your support has helped sustain and strengthen our parish.

As we move ahead in 2026, we invite those who have not yet contributed this year to consider participating in the Annual Appeal. Our parish goal is \$15,525—an achievable amount when shared across our community.

Reaching this goal provides a clear financial benefit: a 2% reduction in next year's assessment. For OLMC, that would lower our 2027 obligation from \$24,205 to about \$20,747, allowing more funds to remain within our parish for local needs.

ANNUAL ²⁰²⁶ APPEAL

Notes on the 2026 Annual Appeal

- This year, OLMC's Annual Appeal Goal is **\$15,525.00**
- If you have already donated, THANK YOU!. Be sure that OLMC Montclair 228, is noted for your donation.
- Every parish who reaches their goal will receive a 2% reduction on the next year's assessment rate (tax of our collection income). For OLMC, our 2027 assessment will be \$24,205, calculated at 14% of our Assessable income of \$172,891.

By meeting our Appeal goal of \$15,525, the rate drops to 12% reducing the Assessment to \$20,747!

That is a 14% savings!

- AND 50% of any money collected over our goal comes back to OLMC to help pay for maintenance and larger projects.
- **BUT If a parish does not reach their goal, the difference will be added to the Assessment.**
