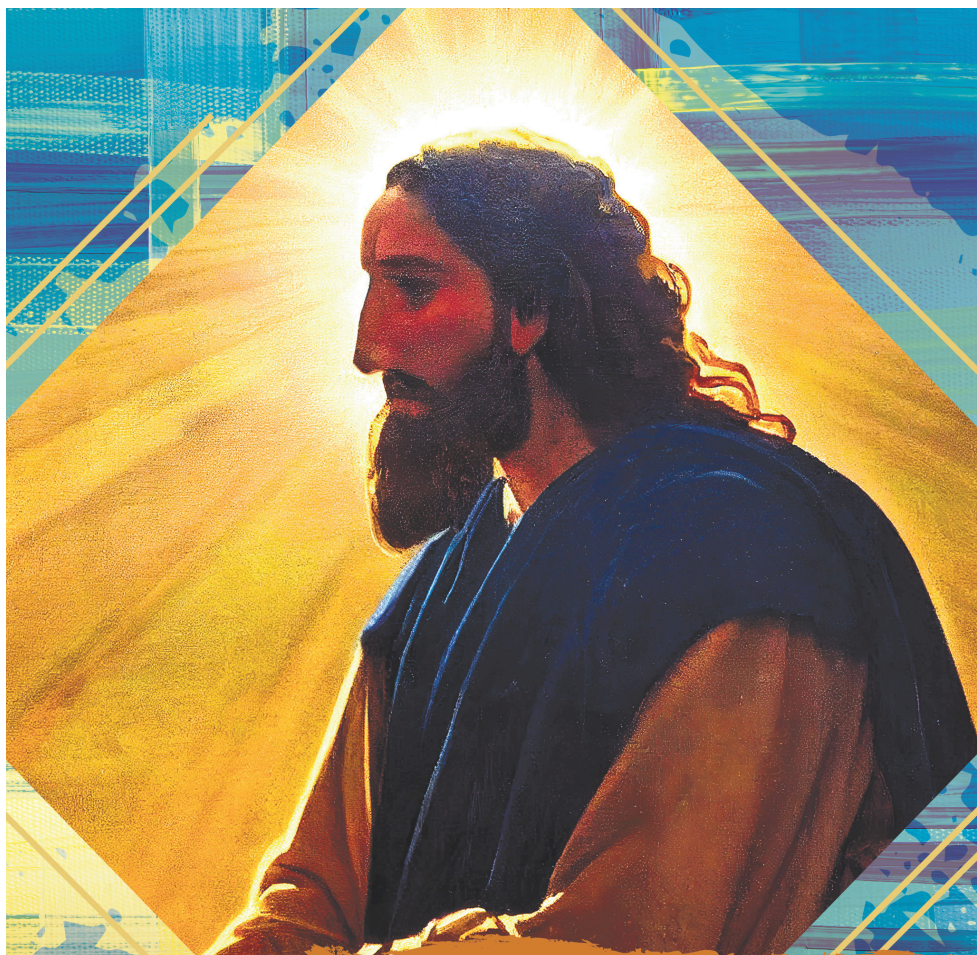

We Are His Witnesses Phase 2

On June 12th, Cardinal Tobin announced the second phase of We Are His Witnesses.

Here are five key points from Cardinal Tobin's letter:



1. **Renewed Focus on Evangelization and Mission**

The We Are His Witnesses initiative is centered on pastoral conversion—moving from maintaining parish structures to actively sharing the Gospel, reaching new people, and strengthening the Church's mission.



2. **Listening and Discernment Have Shaped the Process**

Feedback from parishioners, clergy, religious, and parish leaders through surveys and listening sessions revealed a strong desire for evangelization, outreach, and collaboration among parishes.



3. **Parish Collaboration Will Be the Next Phase**

The Archdiocese is launching **Parish Mission Partners**, encouraging neighboring parishes to work together in evangelization, pastoral care, faith formation, outreach, and long-term sustainability.



4. **Parish Identity Will Be Respected While Exploring New Models**

Collaboration does not mean losing a parish's unique identity. While some communities may eventually discern mergers as the best path forward, mergers do not automatically mean church closures or the loss of parish culture and traditions.



5. **Twelve Pilot Parishes Will Lead the Way**

Twelve parishes in Newark, Bayonne, Scotch Plains, Westfield, Bogota, and Teaneck have been selected to begin this collaborative process, with the goal of developing models that will eventually guide all parishes in the Archdiocese of Newark.

Dear OLMC Members,

Thank you for your past generosity to Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Your support has helped sustain and strengthen our parish.

Notes on the 2026 Annual Appeal

- This year, OLMC's Annual Appeal Goal is **\$15,525.00**
- If you have already donated, THANK YOU!. Be sure that OLMC Montclair 228, is noted for your donation.
- Every parish who reaches their goal will receive a 2% reduction on the next year's assessment rate (tax of our collection income). For OLMC, our 2027 assessment will be \$24,205, calculated at 14% of our Assessable income of \$172,891.

By meeting our Appeal goal of \$15,525, the rate drops to 12% reducing the Assessment to \$20,747!

That is a 14% savings!

- AND 50% of any money collected over our goal comes back to OLMC to help pay for maintenance and larger projects.
- **BUT If a parish does not reach their goal, the difference will be added to the Assessment.**
